WINNEBAGO COUNTY JAIL – BEHAVIORAL HEALTH SERVICES CONTRACT REQUEST FOR PROPOSAL #26P-2467

1. Will we be able to bill for services if a client is determined to be eligible? **Further clarification was needed and not received regarding this question.**
 2. Could you provide additional insight into the deliverables the County would like measured? Any further detail will help us ensure we can accurately track and report the requested data. **We are open to various deliverables but we need to provide timely and accurate reporting to satisfy grant requirements.**
 3. What reporting cadence and performance metrics will the County expect from the behavioral health vendor? Please provide a sample of the current monthly reports received from the current BH provider. **We are open to various deliverables but we need to provide timely and accurate reporting to satisfy grant requirements.**
 4. Regarding MAT services: As Opioid Treatment Programs typically utilize a mental health component, how is this currently managed and what is the expected interface for these services? **Currently this program is managed by 6 staffers made up of Nurse Practitioners and Case Managers. Educational classes are hosted. UIC handles the medication aspect of these services.**
 5. What is the current structure of the Behavioral Health programming? Specifically, does it include educational, religious, substance abuse, or mental health groups? **Yes, programming includes educational, substance abuse, or mental health groups. It does not include religious programming as we have a Chaplin that handles that programming.**
 6. Over the past 12 months, how many patients have received psychotropic medication? **We do not have a specific breakdown we can provide.**
 7. Will the Behavioral Health vendor be responsible for conducting training for all employees regarding Mental Health, Crisis Intervention, and Suicide Prevention and Intervention? **We are open to discussions on opportunities for Annual Behavior Health Training but its currently managed separately.**

8. What are the "on-call" requirements for Mental Health and Psychiatry during off-peak hours? **We are open to suggestions. The team currently seems to have it worked out if needs arise, obviously there is an on-call element to this care being provided at all times.**
9. Are all clinicians required to be licensed? If not, please provide the necessary supervisory structures and requirements. **Yes, licensing is required.**
10. Is the vendor expected to provide hardware such as desktop computers, laptops, and printers? **We will provide hardware equipment.**
