4. All bids shall be submitted in a sealed envelope.

"24B-2357 Public Safety Building Concrete Ramp Snow & Ice Melt Replacement Project

- **5.** Bids shall be submitted in duplicate form.
- **6.** Base Bid includes all work related to removal and replacement of the concrete ramp and snow & ice Melt System at the Public Safety Building.
- **7.** Base Bid should also include the cost of 100 cu yd of removal of unsuitable soil and provide compacted granular backfill in its place.
- 8. Provide a Unit Price for the removal of unsuitable soil and provide compacted granular backfill.
- **9.** Complete all County forms that are included with Bid Form.
- 10. The project is bid out to General Contractors under one contract.
- 11. The supplies and materials used on the project are Tax Exempt and should not be included in the bid amount

- **12.** This project is exempt from Federal Excise Tax.
- **13.** 5% Bid Bond MUST Accompany the Bid.
- 14. 100% Performance & Payment Bond is required for base bid.
- **15.** Liquidated damages are not included in this project.
- **16.** Prevailing wages rates must be in accordance with all federal laws and laws by the state.
- **17.** The owner shall secure and pay for the building permit. Any other permits, fees or notices required shall be paid for by the contractor.
- **18.** The contractor shall coordinate all construction testing with the owners testing agency Testing Services Corporation (TSC). All construction testing will be paid for by the owner.
- 19. Last RFI needs to submit by 4:00pm, Tuesday, September 10, 2024.
- 20. Last Addendum date is Friday, September 13, 2024.
- **21.** Contact Shawn Franks at 815-319-4676 (office) to schedule any additional site visits. Site visits can take place between the hours of 8:00am and 5:00pm, Monday through Friday.
- **22.** Bidders shall address questions and correspondence to the following:

- **23.** A site inspection and date of the inspection is required on the bid form.
- **24.** Mark the addendums you receive on the bid form. Visit Winnebago County's website or contact Hope Edwards the morning the bids are due to make sure you have the correct number of addendums listed on the bid form.
- **25.** Contractor to fill in the subcontractor list on the bid form.
- **26.** Contractors can tap off the existing building's electrical and water services for construction purposes.
- **27.** Contractor shall provide portable toilet facilities.
- **28.** The contractor shall employ a superintendent who shall be in attendance at all times when work is taking place at the project site until substantial completion.
- **29.** Parking is very limited, on street parking may be the only option.
- **30.**Criminal background checks are not required.

- **31.** Smoking or the use of E-Cigarettes and vaping products is allowed outside on site, but it's not permitted within the building.
- **32.** Construction meetings will be held if required. The Contractor is responsible for taking meeting notes and distributing them to all attendees.
- **33.** Contractor's work schedule can be 7:00 AM 5:00 PM. Working weekends are allowed, with prior notification to the owner.
- **34.** The building will remain in operation during construction. Mechanical and electrical shutdowns must be coordinated with the owner. Shut down must not disrupt day to day operations.
- **35.** Bid amounts are valid for up to 120 days after the bid opening.
- **36.** The Contractor shall put on the bid form the number of calendar days the project will take to complete including lead times for equipment.
- **37.**If a dumpster is used for the project, provide plywood under the dumpsters load points when placed on existing pavement.

c.	Start of Construction	Thursday, October 31, 2024
d.	Substantial Completion	Thursday, December 5, 2024

39. The project was briefly reviewed and was followed with a walk-thru of the project site.

Discussion Items

- 1. If contractors want to change the routing of the in-slab tubing, they are required to contact the A/E before proceeding.
- **2.** The under-slab rigid insulation is specified at 40 psi. All joints in the insulation shall be taped.
- **3.** By addendum, the specified gauge for the wire mesh might be changed.
- **4.** By addendum, the contractor will be responsible for scanning the new concrete slab to determine the depth of the in-floor heat tubing.
