2025 Consolidated Primary Election

The following dates are for candidates running in the 2025 Consolidated Primary Election to be held on February 25, 2025, and apply to the offices below:

- 1) Established political parties in municipalities over 5,000 population;
- 2) Townships in Cook County, or townships in other counties with a township population of 15,000 or more where the township central committee has approved a primary;
- 3) Municipalities of 5,000 or less population which by ordinance nominate candidates by primary;
- 4) Municipalities which by referendum conduct a partisan or nonpartisan primary;
- 5) Managerial municipalities which conduct nonpartisan primaries; and
- 6) Candidates for the City of Chicago offices (if a special election is required due to a vacancy in office)

Candidates who are unsure if the office they are running for holds a primary election, a caucus, or if they file directly for the Consolidated Election are encouraged to contact the local election official for the unit of government in question.

The dates included in this abbreviated calendar are not comprehensive of all dates surrounding the election, and do not include all relevant details. For additional detail and statutory references for any of the dates in this calendar, please consult the 2025 Election and Campaign Finance Calendar.

August 15, 2024

Notice of Township Conducting Primary

Last day for the township central committee in counties having a population of over 3,000,000 and townships having a population of over 15,000 in counties of less than 3,000,000 population to notify the appropriate election authority that their specific party will nominate candidates by primary election.

October 21, 2024

First Day to File Petitions for the Consolidated Primary Election

First day to file nomination petitions with the local election official or board of election commissioners for the 2025 Consolidated Primary Election.

October 28, 2024

Last Day to File Petitions for the Consolidated Primary Election

Last day to file nomination petitions with the local election official or board of election commissioners for the 2025 Consolidated Primary Election

Municipal Caucus

Date on which the Municipal Caucus shall be held (in municipalities under 5,000 population) which have established political parties.

December 3, 2024

Township Caucus

Date on which the Township Caucus shall be held (in those townships which have not adopted the primary system).

December 4, 2024

Multi-Township Caucus

Date on which the Multi-Township Caucus shall be held.

December 4, 2024

Last Day to File Objections to Petitions for Public Questions for the Consolidated Primary Election

Last day to file objections to petitions for the submission of questions of public policy with the local election official. Please note that this date accounts for observing November 28 and 29 as holidays; if the office of the local election official is open for a minimum of 7 hours on November 29, the deadline to file objections in that office will be December 3, 2024.

December 9, 2024

Last Day for Resolutions for Public Questions for the Consolidated Primary Election

Last day for local governing boards to adopt a resolution to allow a binding or advisory question to be placed on the ballot at the 2025 Consolidated Primary Election.

December 19, 2024

Ballot Certification Deadline for the Consolidated Primary Election

Last day for the local election official to certify candidates and public questions to the election authority to be included on the 2025 Consolidated Primary ballot.

January 16, 2025

Early Voting Begins for the Consolidated Primary Election

First day for early voting in the office of the election authority and in any additional locations that may have been designated by the election authority.

Voting by Mail Begins for the Consolidated Primary Election

First day for the election authority to mail an official ballot to a voter who has applied for a vote by mail ballot.

First Day to File Caucus Certificate of Nomination

First day established political party caucus certificates of nomination may be filed in the office of the local election official along with Statement of Candidacy and Loyalty Oath (optional) for each candidate. The receipt for filing a Statement of Economic Interest for each candidate may be filed any time during the filing period.

December 16, 2024

Last Day to File Caucus Certificate of Nomination

Last day established political party caucus certificates of nomination may be filed in the office of the local election official along with Statement of Candidacy and Loyalty Oath (optional) for each candidate. The receipt for filing a Statement of Economic Interest for each candidate may be filed any time during the filing period.

December 30, 2025

Last Day to File Petitions for Public Questions for the Consolidated Election

Last day to file petitions with the local election official for the submission of questions of public policy. Exceptions to this date apply for various binding questions or backdoor referenda, please refer to the authorizing statute for the question to confirm the deadline.

January 2, 2025

First Day to Submit Vote by Mail Applications for the Consolidated Election

First day to apply for a vote by mail ballot for the 2025 Consolidated Election. Please note that ballots will not be mailed before Thursday, February 20, 2025.

March 7, 2025

First Day of Early Voting and Voting by Mail if Primary was Held

First day to vote early or by mail if a primary was held in the election jurisdiction.

March 27, 2025

Last Day to Mail Vote by Mail Ballots for the Consolidated Election

Last day for the election authority to receive, by mail, an application for a vote by mail ballot and mail that ballot to the voter. (Note: I. An earlier deadline is applicable to UOCAVA voters; 2. In-person applications are still accepted until March 31, 2025)

P.A. 86-0873 encourages candidates and political committees to subscribe to the Code of

Fair Campaign Practices. The text of the Code is reproduced on the reverse side of this

page. Subscription to the Code is entirely voluntary, but if you do subscribe you will be

entitled to place on your campaign literature a statement that you subscribe to the Code of

Fair Campaign Practices. Subscription entails a moral and ethical obligation to follow

the principles of the Code. If you subscribe to the Code, a copy of your subscription will

be kept on file for public inspection at the Office of the State Board of Elections if yours

is a state political committee or state and local political committee, or at the office of

your County Clerk if yours is a local political committee. Public inspection may take

place from the time you return the subscribed copy of the Code until thirty (30) days after

the election next following your return of the copy.

Please read the Code of Fair Campaign Practices on the reverse page. If you wish to

subscribe, please sign the copy and return it to either (1) your County Clerk if yours is a

local political committee, or (2) to the State Board of Elections in all other cases.

Candidates should sign for candidate committees, and committee chairs should sign for

all other political committees.

CODE OF FAIR CAMPAIGN PRACTICES

There are basic principles of decency, honesty, and fair play which every candidate for public office in the State of Illinois has a moral obligation to observe and uphold, in order that, after vigorously contested but fairly conducted campaigns, our citizens may exercise their constitutional right to a free and untrammeled choice and the will of the people may be fully and clearly expressed on the issues.

THEREFORE:

- I. I will conduct my campaign openly and publicly, and limit attacks on my opponent to legitimate challenges to his record.
- I will not use or permit the use of character defamation, whispering campaigns, libel, slander, or scurrilous attacks on any candidate or his personal or family lift.
- 3. I will not use or permit any appeal to negative prejudice based on race, sex, sexual orientation, religion or national origin.
- 4. I will not use campaign material of any sort which misrepresents, distorts, or otherwise falsifies the facts, nor will I use malicious or unfounded accusations which aim at creating or exploiting doubts, without justification, as to the personal integrity or patriotism of my opposition.
- I will not undertake or condone any dishonest or unethical practice which tends to corrupt or undermine our American system of free elections or which hampers or prevents the full and free expression of the will of the voters.
- 6. I will defend and uphold the right of every qualified American voter to full and equal participation in the electoral process.
- 7. I will immediately and publicly repudiate methods and tactics that may come from others that I have pledged not to use or condone. I shall take firm action against any subordinate who violates any provision of this Code or the laws governing elections.

I, the undersigned, candidate for election to public office in the State of Illinois or chairman of a political committee in support of or opposition to a question of public policy, hereby voluntarily endorse, subscribe to, and solemnly pledge myself to conduct my campaign in accordance with the above principles and practices.

D-5 NOTICE OF OBLIGATION

TO: All Candidates for Nomination, Election or Retention to Public Office and for Questions of Public Policy

This letter is to officially notify you of your filing obligation under Article 9 of the Election Code (An Act to Regulate Campaign Financing).

ALL CAMPAIGN DISCLOSURE DOCUMENTS, INCLUDING THE D-1 STATEMENT OF ORGANIZATION, MUST BE FILED WITH THE STATE BOARD OF ELECTIONS ONLY.

The Act requires a political committee to file a form D-1, Statement of Organization, within 10 business days of the creation of such committee, except any political committee created within the 30 days before an election must file a Statement of Organization within 2 business days. Required forms and A Guide to Campaign Disclosure are available from the Board offices and online. Failure to file or late filing of a Statement of Organization will result in a civil penalty being imposed by the Board.

Committees who must file fall within five categories: Candidate Political Committee, Political Party Committee, Political Action Committee, Ballot Initiative Committee, or Independent Expenditure Committee.

10 ILCS 5/9-1.8 Political Committees

Candidate Political Committee: means the candidate himself or herself or any natural person, trust, partnership, corporation, or other organization or group of persons designated by the candidate that accepts contributions or makes expenditures during any 12 month period in an aggregate amount exceeding \$5000 on behalf of the candidate.

Political Party Committee: means the State central committee of a political party, a county central committee of a political party, a legislative caucus committee, or a committee formed by a ward or township committeeman of a political party. A legislative caucus committee means a committee established for the purpose of electing candidates to the General Assembly by the person elected President of the Senate, Minority Leader of the Senate, Speaker of the House of Representatives, Minority Leader of the House of Representatives, or a committee established by 5 or more members of the same caucus of the Senate or 10 or more members of the same caucus of the House of Representatives.

Political Action Committee: means any natural person, trust, partnership, committee, association corporation, or other organization or group of persons, other than a candidate, political party, candidate political committee, or political party committee, that accepts contributions or makes expenditures during any 12 month period in an aggregate of amount exceeding \$5000 on behalf of or in opposition to a candidate or candidates for political office. Political Action Committee includes any natural person, trust, partnership, committee, association, corporation, or other organization or group of persons, other than a candidate, political party, candidate political committee, or political party committee, that makes electioneering communications during any 12 month period in an aggregate amount exceeding \$5000 related to any candidate or candidates for public office.

Ballot Initiative Committee: means any natural person, trust, partnership, committee, association, corporation, or other organization or group of persons that accepts contributions or makes expenditures during any 12 month period in an aggregate amount exceeding \$5000 in support of or in opposition to any question of public policy to be submitted to the electors. Ballot initiative committee includes any natural person, trust, partnership, committee, association, corporation, or other organization or group of persons that makes electioneering communications during any 12 month period in an aggregate amount exceeding \$5000 related to any question of public policy to be submitted to the voters. The \$5000 threshold applies to any contributions or expenditures received or made with the purpose of securing a place on the ballot for, advocating the defeat or passage of, or engaging in electioneering communication regarding the question of public policy, regardless of the method of initiation of the question of public policy and regardless of whether petitions have been circulated or filed with the appropriate office or whether the question has been adopted and certified by the governing body.

Independent Expenditure Committee: means any trust, partnership, committee, association, corporation, or other organization or group of persons formed for the exclusive purpose of making independent expenditures during any 12-month period in an aggregate amount exceeding \$5000 in support of or in opposition to (i) the nomination for election, election, retention, or defeat of any public official or candidate or (ii) any question of public policy to be submitted to the electors. "Independent expenditure committee" also includes any trust, partnership, committee, association, corporation, or other organization or group of persons that makes electioneering communications that are not made in connection, consultation, or concert with or at the request or suggestion of a public official or candidate, a public official's or candidate's designated political committee or campaign, or an agent or agents of the public official, candidate, or political committee or campaign during any 12-month period in an aggregate amount exceeding \$5000 related to (i) the nomination for election, election, retention, or defeat of any public official or candidate or (ii) any question of public policy to be submitted to the voters.

Notice To Candidates Who Have Changed Names Within The Last Three Years

P.A. 94-1090, Effective June 1, 2007 amended 10 ILCS 5/7-10.2, 10 ILCS 5/8-8.1 and 10 ILCS 5/10-5.1 to add the following requirement:

If a candidate has changed his or her name, whether by a statutory or common law procedure in Illinois or any other jurisdiction, within 3 years before the last day for filing the petition or certificate for that office, whichever is applicable, then (i) the candidate's name on the petition or certificate must be followed by "formerly known as (list all prior names during the 3-year period) until name changed on (list date of each such name change)" and (ii) the petition or certificate must be accompanied by the candidate's affidavit stating the candidate's previous names during the period specified in (i) and the date or dates each of those names was changed; failure to meet these requirements shall be grounds for denying certification of the candidate's name for the ballot or removing the candidate's name from the ballot, as appropriate, but these requirements do not apply to name changes resulting from adoption to assume an adoptive parent's or parents' surname, marriage to assume a spouse's surname, or dissolution of marriage or declaration of invalidity of marriage to assume a former surname.

Pursuant to P.A. 94-1090 and 10 ILCS 5/16-3, said information shall appear on the ballot along with the candidate's current name.
