The program is a collaborative effort with Criminal Justice agencies that operate in Winnebago County, the Winnebago County Board Chair Office and community buy in with Get Connected 815 including Navigator assistance. Loyola University's Center for Criminal Justice and Center for Urban Research and Learning also supports the process. The team meets quarterly identifying individuals at high risk of reoffending, currently on probation and parole.
