**RESOLUTION CONDEMNING ILLINOIS GOVERNOR J.B. PRITZKER'S
STATEMENTS REGARDING REPUBLICANS IN A NEW HAMPSHIRE SPEECH**

WHEREAS, on April 27, 2025, Illinois Governor J.B. Pritzker delivered a speech at a Democratic fundraiser in the state of New Hampshire; and

WHEREAS, in Governor Pritzker's speech, he stated in part that "never before in my life have I called for mass protest, for mobilization, for disruption, but I am now. These Republicans cannot know a moment of peace"; and

WHEREAS, federal law, 18 U.S.C. 373, constitutes it as a felony to intentionally solicit, command, induce, or otherwise endeavor to persuade another person to engage in a crime of violence against person or property; and

WHEREAS, the County Board of the County of Winnebago, Illinois has a top priority in public safety and to the residents of Winnebago County; and

WHEREAS, the Winnebago County Board believes that Governor Pritzker's statements were inflammatory, divisive, and they took aim at elected officials and Americans of the Republican Party; and

WHEREAS, the Winnebago County Board condemns Governor Pritzker's statements because they jeopardize public safety.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the County Board of the County of Winnebago, Illinois, that it condemns Illinois Governor J.B. Pritzker's statements regarding republicans made on April 27, 2025 in the state of New Hampshire at a Democratic fundraiser because the statements were inflammatory, divisive and jeopardize public safety.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that this Resolution shall be in full force and effect immediately upon its adoption.
