Background Information: The Winnebago County Sheriff's Office (WCSO) requested the purchase of one (1) 2025 Ford Explorer - Police Interceptor Vehicle using CIP 2026 funds. The Purchasing Department and the Sheriff's Office reached out for quotes and availability. Stivers Ford & Stivers Midwest Pro Upfitters provided vehicle quotes and specialized outfitting options (See Resolution Exhibit A). Background Information: The Purchasing Department manages a fleet of (11) vehicles for the Winnebago County Vehicle Pool. Within this vehicle pool, the following departments have vehicles, (5) Community Development, (1) Public Defender and (5) the County Vehicle Pool which allows departments to request vehicles for various county business.

We are continuing to replace the Community Development Department vehicles for the inspectors. We have several high mileage vehicles needing more expensive repairs.

The intent of purchasing two vehicles will be that we sell two vehicles, one with about 110,000 miles and the other with 140,000 miles. This will allow us to shift vehicles around the entire 11 vehicle fleet to better accommodate the vehicle pool needs.
