RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING AN INCREASE IN THE SALARY OF THE WINNEBAGO COUNTY PUBLIC DEFENDER

WHEREAS, the County of Winnebago, Illinois, is responsible for the salary of the Winnebago County Public Defender; and

WHEREAS, the salary of a county public defender is established by 55 ILCS 5/3-4007 at 90% of the compensation of the state's attorney of the county, 66 2/3 % of which is to be reimbursed by the State; and

WHEREAS, the General Assembly has recently increased the salary of the Winnebago County State's Attorney necessitating an adjustment in the salary of the Winnebago County Public Defender.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the County Board of the County of Winnebago that the salary of the Winnebago County Public Defender shall be adjusted to be 90% of the current salary of the Winnebago County State's Attorney retroactive to the date the change in the State's Attorney's salary became effective.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that this Resolution shall be in full force and effect immediately upon its adoption.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Clerk of the County Board is hereby authorized to prepare and deliver certified copies of this Resolution to the Chief Judge of the 17th Judicial Circuit, the Winnebago County Public Defender and the Winnebago County Finance Department.

AMENDMENT NO. 1

TO

THE AGREEEMNT FOR THE PROVISION OF INMATE MENTAL HEALTH SERVICES, WINNEBAGO COUNTY, ILLINOIS

Whereas, on November 1, 2017 Advanced Correctional Healthcare, Inc. (hereinafter referred to as "ACH") entered into an contract (hereinafter referred to as "Agreement") with the County of Winnebago and the Winnebago County Sheriff pursuant to which ACH agreed to provide mental health services to the inmates of the Winnebago County Jail; and

Whereas, Section 4.1 of the Agreement provides the Agreement commenced on November 27, 2017 and will terminate on November 30, 2018 unless extended or renewed; and

Whereas, ACH has continuously provided mental health services to the inmates of the Winnebago County Jail since November 27, 2018; and

Whereas, the County of Winnebago, the Winnebago County Sheriff, and ACH desire to extend the term of the Agreement through March 31, 2019.

Now, therefore, in consideration of the mutual covenants contained herein, and with the intent to be legally bound hereby, it is agreed by and between the parties as follows:

- I. Section 4.1 of ARTICLE 4: TERM AND TERMINATION of the Agreement is hereby amended to read as follows:
 - **4.1 TERM.** This AGREEMENT, which commenced on November 27, 2017 at 12:01 a.m., will continue in full force and effect until March 31, 2019 at 11:59 p.m., unless earlier terminated, extended, or renewed as provided by this AGREEMENT.
- II. Section 3.2 of ARTICLE 3: COMPENSATION/ADJUSTMENTS of the Agreement is hereby amended to read as follows:
 - 3.2 MONTHLY PAYMENTS. For the month of November, 2018 the COUNTY will pay ACH nine thousand eight hundred sixty-nine dollars and sixty-three cents (\$9,869.63). For the remainder of the term of this AGREEMENT the COUNTY will pay ACH ten thousand, one hundred sixteen dollars and 37 cents (\$10,116.37) per month. ACH will bill the COUNTY approximately thirty (30) days prior to the month in which services are to be rendered. The COUNTY agrees to pay ACH in accordance with the Illinois Local Government Prompt Payment Act (50 ILCS 505).
- III. In all other respects, the Agreement is hereby reaffirmed and ratified. All other terms and conditions remain as stated in the original Agreement signed by ACH

on November 1, 2017, the Chairman of the Winnebago County Board on October 26, 2017, and the Winnebago County Sheriff on October 27, 2017.

RESOLUTION FOR INFRASTRUCTURE CONTRIBUTION FOR THE I-90 AND RIVERSIDE BLVD. AREA TO THE CITY OF LOVES PARK USING HOST FEES

WHEREAS, the County Board of the County of Winnebago, Illinois, previously approved an Ordinance Adopting a Host Fee Allocation and Award Policy for the use and allocation of host fee funds for economic development which sets forth categories of investment for these funds; and

WHEREAS, the County Board has determined that host fee funds are to be used for economic development, defined as growth-oriented community investment that benefits Winnebago County citizens and improves economic well-being and quality of life in the County; and

WHEREAS, the four categories of economic development encompassed by this policy are capital development, workforce development, infrastructure, and community development; and

WHEREAS, the County Board has determined that infrastructure improvements essential for commercial development at the I-90 and Riverside Blvd. area in the City of Loves Park would economically benefit Winnebago County as a whole and would be an appropriate expenditure of host fee funds.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT AND IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED, by the County Board of the County of Winnebago, Illinois, that the County of Winnebago allocate host fees to the City of Loves Park, Illinois for infrastructure improvements in the I-90 and Riverside Blvd area in the amounts and to be paid as follows: (i) \$600,000 prior to April 30, 2019; and (ii) \$1,100,000 to be paid in four consecutive annual installments of \$275,000 due on April 30th of each year beginning on April 30, 2020. The initial payment shall not be due or shall be refunded by the City of Loves Park if the proposed development at the northeast corner of I-90 and Riverside Blvd. of approximately 150,000 square feet does not occur. The annual installments shall only be due if the anchor business at that location is operating at the time the payment is due. Should the anchor business cease operations within five years of the last payment due date, the City of Loves Park shall refund to the County of Winnebago \$1,700,000. Prior

to any payment being made, the County of Winnebago and City of Loves Park shall enter into an intergovernmental agreement reflecting the terms set forth above.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Clerk of the County Board is hereby directed to prepare and deliver copies of this resolution to the Winnebago County Administrator and the Winnebago County Auditor.

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ANNUAL SERVICES AGREEMENT WITH WILLETT HOFMANN & ASSOCIATES, FOR BRIDGE PERMIT ANALYSIS FOR VARIOUS COUNTY, CITY AND TOWNSHIP STRUCTURES

The County of Winnebago, Illinois, hereinafter referred to as the "COUNTY" and Willett Hofmann and Associates, hereinafter referred to as "WILLETT", for the consideration hereinafter set forth hereby agree as follows:

I. SCOPE OF SERVICES. WILLETT shall provide to the COUNTY professional engineering services for bridge permit analysis for various structures of various types and various lengths at various locations throughout the COUNTY for the COUNTY and for various cities and townships within the COUNTY on a work order basis issued by the County Engineer as per the scope of services and fees outlined in the "Preliminary Engineering Services Agreement" herein attached as Exhibit "A".

II. TERMS OF AGREEMENT

A. WILLETT AGREES:

- 1. That upon receipt of a request for services from the COUNTY, WILLETT shall submit to the COUNTY the following information:
 - a. Detailed scope of services for the specific project.
 - b. A preliminary project schedule.
 - c. An opinion of fee for the required services. The opinion of fee will not be considered a maximum fee, but rather an estimate to be used for budgetary purposes.
 - d. A statement referencing this Agreement.
- 2. WILLETT shall not proceed with any of the services to be provided under this agreement until a letter authorizing them to proceed is issued by the County Engineer.
- 3. That all plans, reports and other documents furnished by WILLETT, pursuant to this Agreement, will be in accordance with current and applicable standards, specifications, and polices and when applicable to those of the State of Illinois Department of Transportation. It is understood by WILLETT that all reports, plans and drafts will be, before being finally accepted, subject to approval by the COUNTY.
- 4. That in the event plans or surveys are found to be in error and revisions or corrections of the plans or surveys are required, WILLETT agrees to give immediate attention to and promptly make any changes or corrections and perform such work

- without cost to the COUNTY, even if final payment has been received by WILLETT.
- 5. That all sketches, charts, computations and other data prepared or obtained by WILLETT pursuant to this Agreement will be made available, upon request, to the County Engineer without cost.
- 6. That all plans, certifications, and other documents furnished by WILLETT pursuant to this Agreement will be endorsed by and will show the seal and signature of an Illinois Registered Professional Engineer where such is required by law.

B. BASIS OF PAYMENT:

- 1. For the services provided herein, the COUNTY will pay in accordance with the fee schedule shown in the attached Exhibit "A" up to the stated not-to exceed price (fee) as noted in the given work order.
- 2. The COUNTY will make partial payments to WILLETT, but they shall be limited to no more than 90% of the total fee until the final documents are delivered and accepted by the County Engineer. The cumulative sum of the partial payments will be proportional to the amount of the work completed as determined by the County Engineer. Payment will be made to WILLETT within 60 days after receipt of a detailed invoice showing hours, hourly rates, and other expenses for each task performed.

III. EFFECTIVE DATES.

A. LENGTH OF CONTRACT.

This Agreement shall commence on the date of execution by both of the parties hereto, and shall terminate on September 30, 2019 or when WILLETT completes the work described herein, whichever is sooner. If said work orders extend beyond the ending date, WILLETT will complete all of the work as agreed to in said work orders.

B. EXTENSION OF CONTRACT

After September 30, 2019, the County Engineer, at his discretion, may renew this Agreement with WILLETT for a term to expire on September 30, 2020. Fees will be determined by rates established in an updated fee schedule attached in Exhibit "A" effective on October 1, 2019.

IV. <u>LIMITATION OF LIABILITY</u>. The liability of the COUNTY and its employees is limited to the responsibilities and duties described in Article I of this Agreement. WILLETT shall indemnify and save harmless the COUNTY and its employees against any and all loss, damage, liability, judgments, costs and reasonable attorney's fees arising out of WILLETT'S negligent acts or omissions under this Agreement.

- V. <u>SUCCESSORS AND ASSIGNS</u>. This Agreement shall be binding upon and inure to the benefit of the parties hereto and their respective successors and assigns.
- VI. EXTENT OF AGREEMENT. This Agreement represents the entire and integrated Agreement between the COUNTY and WILLETT and supersedes all prior negotiations and representations, either written or oral. None of the provisions of this Agreement may be waived, changed, or modified except by an instrument in writing signed by both parties.
- VII. <u>INDEPENDENT CONTRACTOR RELATIONSHIP</u>. The parties hereto acknowledge and agree that the relationship created by this Agreement is a principal-independent contractor relationship, not an employer-employee relationship.
