EMD Protocols and ISO Credit

• New EMD protocols will enhance call-taking efficiency for EMS and fire departments, and will help secure additional ISO credit for fire departments served.

Staffing and Training Progress

- The center is progressing well. Two offer letters were sent out this week, leaving only two TC positions to be filled.
- Two TC's are currently in training and are expected to be released mid-November.
- Recent focus on training: TC's have completed mandatory liability training and earned TCPR certificates. TCPR is a new method used to guide callers through CPR instructions over the phone.
- Supervisors are conducting monthly remedial trainings with released TC's to ensure they stay current with all policies and procedures.

Call Response Standards

• The center is meeting state and department standards by answering all 911 calls within 15 seconds, often reaching the internal goal of 10 seconds.

Facility Updates

• Kitchen remodel is complete; work on the workout center in the basement is ongoing. Plans to create a recharge room for staff are in progress.

Radio Infrastructure Project
